PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEO RECORDING POLICY

Oxford Golf Club recognises the positive benefits of using photography and video recording in a range of situations (e.g. coaching, promoting golf). The Club is also aware that there is evidence that some people have used sporting events as an opportunity to take inappropriate photographs or film footage of young and disabled sportspeople in vulnerable positions.

To protect young and/or vulnerable persons the Club has adopted the following key principles concerning the use of photographic and video recording equipment:

- The interests and welfare of children taking part in golf are paramount.
- Parents and children have a right to decide whether children's images are to be taken, and how they may be used.
- Parents must provide written consent for children's images to be taken and used.
- Images should convey the best principles and aspects of golf.
- Care should be taken to ensure that images are neither sexual nor exploitative in nature, nor open to misinterpretation and misuse.
- Efforts should be taken to ensure that images should only be taken by authorised persons, as agreed in the protocol for a particular event.
- All images of children should be securely stored.
